An internationally known scholar on the law of war, Dr. Gary Solis is an adjunct Professor of Law at Georgetown University Law Center and a member of the faculty at the International Institute of Humanitarian Law in San Remo, Italy. In 2006 he retired as a Professor of Law at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, where he had taught since 1996, directed the law of war program, and been awarded the Apgar Award as outstanding professor.

Professor Solis graduated from King Hall in 1971, with the third graduating class. He is a retired U.S. Marine with twenty-six years active service. He came to Davis a few months after his second Vietnam tour of duty and, after graduation, returned to active duty. In the following eighteen years he was a Marine judge advocate, a court-martial judge, and the Head of the Marine Corps' Military Law Branch in Washington, D.C. He earned his LL.M (criminal law) from George Washington University and his Ph.D. (law of war) from the London School of Economics & Political Science, where he also taught before moving to West Point.
